



CalAIM Justice-Involved Initiative: Impact on Probation & Juvenile Justice

Detained adolescents often grapple with multiple health challenges, with substance use disorders (SUD) being predominant in this population. The CalAIM Justice-Involved (JI) Initiative is an opportunity to enhance access to effective treatment, services and supports to improve outcomes for justice involved youth and their families.

CalAIM JI provides guidelines to help providers and facilities serving youth adopt standardized screening and assessment tools for SUD; improve SUD counseling services; implement and expand medications for addiction treatment (MAT) for youth in detention; ensure comprehensive care management plans inclusive of SUD needs; and support successful reentry through warm handoffs to community-based providers.

During this session, participants will hear about:

- The SUD needs of justice-involved youth.
- The requirements of the CalAIM JI Initiative related to SUD, opioid use disorder (OUD), and MAT.
- Identification of opportunities for integrating county-wide efforts for MAT, pre-release services, reentry, and enhanced care management (ECM).

This webinar is intended for members of county-based CA teams working to expand access to MAT for persons with justice system or child welfare involvement and their key partners and stakeholders. *MAT in Jails and Drug Courts* is funded by DHCS with general state funds as a program in DHCS' MAT Expansion Project.
