While engaging in behavioral interventions/therapies should never be a requirement for detainees to receive medication-assisted treatment (MAT), these services can enhance your MAT program and improve outcomes for individuals in your correctional facility.

HMA facilitators will provide a brief overview of behavioral interventions/therapies suitable for the jail setting and justice-involved population and discuss how to assess the “right” evidence-based intervention for patients in your facility. During this session, county team members will have an opportunity to discuss their own facilities’ efforts and plans and receive input from HMA subject matter experts and their counterparts in other counties.
